

Establish an Award in Your Name

Supporting students through scholarships, bursaries, and awards is a meaningful way to make a lasting impact. Donors can establish a named award by selecting a funding pathway, choosing an award type, and customizing criteria to align with their philanthropic vision.

FUNDING PATHWAYS:

Endowed Award

A permanently established fund that is responsibly invested to generate sustainable financial support. Each year, a portion of the interest income is awarded to students.

- Investment: starting at \$50,000+

Term-funded/Expendable

A flexible option where donors pledge support for a minimum of three years to provide immediate financial assistance to students.

- Investment: starting at \$5,000+

AWARD TYPES:

Scholarship

Recognizes academic excellence in a specific program. May include other non-academic criteria.

Award

Balances academic merit and financial need. May include other non-academic criteria.

Bursary

Provides financial assistance based solely on financial need. Due to privacy considerations, recipient names are not disclosed to donors.

Prize

Honours top students based on academic performance in a course, program, or competition.
